AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE GENERAL SALARY ORDINANCE NO. 2023-170 TO AMEND SECTION 9-008 FOR SCHOOL GUARDS; REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STRONGSVILLE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 9-008 of Article 9 Compensation for Specific Positions of the General Salary Ordinance, concerning the compensation for School Guards, be and is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

ARTICLE 9 Compensation for Specific Positions

9-008 SCHOOL GUARDS.

Each school guard employed by the City in locations on school grounds or at points immediately adjacent thereto shall be paid Thirteen and 86/100 Dollars (\$13.86) Eighteen and 00/100 Dollars (\$18.00) for each session actually worked each school day. "Session" shall mean the time of day for school guard service before schools open, during the lunch period, or after schools close.

Section 2. That the funds for the purposes of this Ordinance have been appropriated and shall be paid from the General Fund.

Section 3. That all other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees, that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City, and for the further reason that it is necessary to amend this section of the General Salary Ordinance to reflect the intent of the City with regard to providing fair compensation for school guard employees of the City of Strongsville, and conserve public funds. Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
